Any RFP Addenda will be issued on the website and processed in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A11-23(c)(1). All interested respondents should check the website from now through RFP opening. PURPOSE OF REQUEST

The Linden Roselle Sewerage Authority is requesting proposals from qualified individuals and/or firms to provide Auditing services of a specialized nature to the Authority as more particularly described herein. Proposals will be evaluated in accordance with the criteria set forth in the RFP.

SUBMISSION DATE AND TIME

September 30, 2020 at 10 A.M.

One (1) Original and One (1) copy. Clearly mark the submittal package with the title of the RFP and the name of the responding firm, addressed to the Purchasing Manager. The original proposal shall be marked to distinguish it from the copy. Only those responses received prior to or on the submission date and time will be considered. Sealed proposals may be hand delivered or mailed consistent with the provisions of the Notice of RFP. In the case of mailed proposals, the Authority assumes no responsibility for proposals forwarded by mail and/or delivery services, of any nature. Any proposal received after the designated date and time will be returned unopened. Proposals will not be accepted by facsimile or email.

PERIOD OF CONTRACT

One year commencing upon notice from the Authority.

PAYMENT

The successful proposer, when awarded a contract, shall submit invoices which specify in detail, the period for which payment is claimed, the services performed during the prescribed period, the amount claimed and correlation between the services claimed and the Cost Proposal. It is also agreed and understood that the acceptance of the final payment by Contractor shall be considered a release in full of all claims against the Authority arising out of, or by reason of, the work done and materials furnished under this Contract.

INTERPRETATION AND ADDENDA

Respondents are expected to examine the RFP with care and observe all its requirements. All questions about the meaning or intent of this document, all interpretations and clarifications considered necessary by the owner's representative in response to such comments and questions will be issued by Addenda posted to the website and mailed or delivered to all parties *recorded* as having received the RFP package. Only comments and questions responded to by formal written Addenda will be binding. Oral interpretations, statements or clarifications are without legal effect.

DETAILED REQUIREMENTS OF THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR AUDITING SERVICES

1. LINDEN ROSELLE SEWERAGE AUTHORITY-DESCRIPTION

The Linden Roselle Sewerage Authority (“The Authority”) is a local public body created in 1948 by the City of Linden and Borough of Roselle under the “Sewerage Authorities Law” (N.J.S.A.40:14A-1 et seq.) It was established to contract and operate wastewater treatment and interceptor facilities to collect, treat and dispose of sewerage generated by the municipalities under a Municipal Agreement dated December 6, 1949 and as later amended.

The Authority operations are overseen by the six Members of the Board and day to day operations and administration are conducted by a staff headed by an Executive Director.

The Authority’s service area is 13 square miles and it services a residential population of 60,000. Approximately 25% of the influent sewerage flow is from industrial sources.

The Authority is governed by federal and state regulation. It operates its facilities and discharges treated wastewater to the Arthur Kill under permit No. 0024953 issued by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (N.J.D.E.P). A portion of the effluent is permitted for beneficial reuse for cooling water for electric power generated at an adjacent power plant.

The Authority employs 46 people in four departments:

- Administration – Business
- Monitoring – Environmental Compliance
- Operations
- Maintenance

The Authority owns administration, monitoring/laboratory, treatment facilities and various auxiliary buildings at its primary site at 5005 South Wood Ave., Linden, NJ. It also owns a dock facility at the Arthur Kill, two pump stations, one metering chamber and pipelines outside of its treatment plant site.

The Authority’s sewerage treatment is classified as “Secondary Treatment” and is designed to treat 17 million gallons per day. It consists of Primary sedimentation, activated sludge, aeration, secondary clarifiers and ultraviolet disinfection for final effluent.

Residuals (sludge) treatment is by gravity thickening of primary sludge, gravity belt thickening (for waste activated sludge). Residuals are anaerobically digested and resulting methane gas is utilized for heat or flared (incinerated)

Residual sludge is concentrated with polymer. Final residuals are removed and disposed of off-site by a private contractor. The Authority’s 2020 operating budget is approximately \$10,000,000.

2. NATURE/SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Linden Roselle Sewerage Authority is requesting proposals from qualified individuals and firms to provide the following services:

A. Annual Audit/Consultant Services

The auditor/consultant is retained by the Authority for a period of one year to render general accounting/ auditing /consultant services, including the preparation and certification of the annual audit of accounts in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:14A-7.1. The Audit shall be completed and filed with the Authority within five months after the close of the 2020 fiscal year. The Auditor /Consultant will also perform a single Audit Report in accordance with Uniform Guidance standards if deemed necessary. Consulting services of a technical/advisory nature relating to various accounting, financial and budgetary matters may also be required.

The audit must be done in accordance with U.S. Generally Accepted Auditing Standards and the standards applicable to financial statements contained in the Government Auditing Standards issued by the Comptroller General of the United States, the audit requirements prescribed by the Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs, State of New Jersey, the U.S. Office of Management and Budget Uniform Guidance provisions and State of New Jersey OMB Circular Letter 15-08.

3. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS OF TECHNICAL PROPOSAL

The Proposal submitted by the Respondent must meet or exceed the professional and administrative qualifications and requirements set forth in this RFP to perform these services and shall incorporate the information requested below. In addition to the information required as described below, a Respondent may submit supplemental information that it feels may be useful in evaluating its proposal.

- A. Provide the name of the proposer, brief details of the firm's principal activities, the number of personnel in the firm and the firm's location.
- B. Proposer must have a multi-disciplinary accounting practice with demonstrable expertise in State of New Jersey local governmental accounting and finance for a minimum of fifteen (15) years.
- C. Proposer must have a minimum of ten (10) years servicing the Linden Roselle Sewerage Authority or other similar governmental entities. A listing of other engagements where services of the types being proposed must be submitted. This should include other sewerage/municipal utility authorities and municipal governments. Contact information for the recipients of the similar services must be provided. The Authority may obtain references from any of the parties listed.
- D. Provide the education, qualifications, experience, and credentials of all persons who would be assigned to provide services along with their names and titles.
- E. Must be both a Certified Public Accountant and be licensed by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services as a Registered Municipal Accounting Firm.
- F. A Statement that neither the firm nor any individuals assigned to this engagement are suspended, or otherwise prohibited from professional practice by any federal, state, or local agency.

- G. An EEO/Affirmative Action Statement (copy of form attached).
- H. A completed Non-Collusion Affidavit (copy of form attached).
- I. A statement that the proposer will comply with the General Terms and Conditions required by the Authority and enter into the Authority's standard Professional Services Contract.
- J. A copy of the proposer's Business Registration Certificate. (Proposer must possess and submit Certificate by contract award date. Submission with proposal is preferred).
- K. Statement of Corporate or Partnership Ownership (copy of form attached).
- L. Disclosure of Investment Activities in Iran (copy of form attached).

4. COST PROPOSAL

Proposers shall submit a cost proposal which would include any proposed retainer, the services to be provided for the retainer, if the services will be provided at a flat rate, if all or any services will be billed through hourly rates and what are the established rate(s). The cost proposal shall include a price for the preparation and certification of the annual audit of accounts of LRSA in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:14A-7.1, which shall be completed within four months after the close of the 2019 fiscal year. A separate price for the performance of the Single Audit, if necessary, to be performed, should be provided. During the course of the year, the Authority may require consulting services of a technical/advisory nature relating to various accounting, financial and budgetary matters. Hourly rates to provide these services should also be provided. The Authority does not provide payment for or reimbursement for travel expenses.

5. PROPOSAL EVALUATION

The Authority will select the most advantageous proposals based on all of the evaluation factors set forth at the end of this RFP. The Authority will make the award that is in the best interest of the Authority. RFP responses shall remain open for a period of sixty (60) calendar days from the submittal date. The Authority may either award the contract within the applicable time period or reject all proposals. The Authority may extend the decision to award or reject all proposals beyond the sixty (60) calendar days when the proposals of any respondents who consent thereto, may, at the request of the Authority, be held for consideration for such longer period as may be agreed.

Each proposal must satisfy the objectives and requirements detailed in this RFP. The successful proposer shall be determined by an evaluation of the total content of the proposal submitted. The Authority reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, or to reject any proposals if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of such respondent fails to satisfy the Authority that the respondent is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the RFP and to complete the work contemplated therein. The Authority reserves the right to waive any minor informality in the RFP.

The Authority shall not be obligated to explain the results of the evaluation process to any proposer.

The Authority may require proposers to demonstrate any services described in their proposal prior to award.

6. PROPOSAL LIMITATIONS

This RFP is not intended to be an offer, order or contract and should not be regarded as such, nor shall any obligation or liability be imposed on the Authority by issuance of this RFP.

7. USE OF INFORMATION

Any specifications, drawings, sketches, models, samples, data, computer programs, documentation, technical or business information and the like (“Information”) furnished or disclosed by the Authority to the proposer in connection with this RFP shall remain the property of the Authority. When in tangible form, all copies of such information shall be returned to the Authority upon request. Unless such information was previously known to the proposer, free of any obligation to keep it confidential, or has been or is subsequently made public by the Authority or a third party, it shall be held in confidence by the proposer, shall be used only for the purposes of this RFP, and may not be used for other purposes except upon such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon in writing.

8. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- A. In case of failure by the successful proposer, the Authority may procure the articles or services from other sources, deduct the cost of the replacement from money due to the proposer under the contract and hold the proposer responsible for any excess cost occasioned thereby.
- B. The proposer shall maintain sufficient insurance to protect against all claims under Workmen’s Compensation, General, Professional and Automobile Liability. Certificates of Insurance shall be provided when requested with the Authority named as additional insured.
- C. Each proposal must be signed by the person authorized to do so.
- D. Sealed proposals may be hand delivered or mailed consistent with the provisions of the legal notice to proposers. In the case of mailed proposals, the Authority assumes no responsibility for proposals received after the designated date and time and will return late proposals unopened. Proposals **will not** be accepted by facsimile or e-mail.
- E. No firm may be issued a contract unless it complies with the EEO/Affirmative Action requirements of P.L.1975 C.127 as identified in the documents attached hereto. The form shall be properly executed.
- F. By submission of the proposal, the proposer certifies that the service to be furnished will not infringe upon any valid patent, trademark or copyright and the successful proposer shall, at its expense, defend any and all actions or suits charging such infringement, and will save the Authority harmless in any case of any such infringement.
- G. No proposer shall influence, or attempt to influence, or cause to be influenced, any Authority Member or employee to use his/her official capacity in any manner which might tend to impair the objectivity or independence of judgment of said officer or employee.
- H. No proposer shall cause or influence, or attempt to cause or influence, any Authority Member or employee to use his/her official capacity to secure unwarranted privileges or advantages for the proposer or any other person.
- I. Should any difference arise between the contracting parties as to the meaning or intent of these instructions or specifications, the Authority’s decision shall be final and conclusive.
- J. The Authority shall not be responsible for any expenditure of monies or other expenses incurred by the proposer in making its proposal.

- K. The checklist, affidavits, notices and the like presented at the end of this Request for Proposals are a part of this Request for Proposals and shall be completed and submitted as part of this proposal.
- L. “Pay to Play”- Notice of Disclosure Requirement-P.L. 2005, Chapter 271: Any business entity that has received \$50,000 or more in contracts from government entities in a calendar year is required to file an annual disclosure report with ELEC. The instructions and form are available on the ELEC website. Annual disclosures require submission by March 30th of each year covering contracts and contributions for the prior calendar year. - M. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:44-2.2, the selected firm shall maintain all documentation related to products, transactions, or services under this contract for a period of five years from the date of final payment. Such records shall be made available to the New Jersey Office of the State Comptroller upon request.
- N. P. L. 2018, c. 127 establishes a prompt payment requirement that applies to goods and services contracts a contracting unit awards to a “business concern” under the Local Public Contracts Law (LPCL). The law applies to all goods and services contracts awarded on or after February 1, 2019 (the law’s effective date) regardless of dollar amount and any contracts requiring either a single payment or multiple payments. The law does not change the prompt payment requirements for improvements to real property and structures as set forth in N.J.S.A. 2A:30A-1 et seq. and described in LFN 2006-21. The law defines “Business Concern” as any person engaged in a trade or business, including a private nonprofit entity operating as an independent contractor, providing goods and services directly to a contracting unit or to a designated third party and operating pursuant to a contract with a contracting unit which requires either a single payment or multiple payments, but shall not include a “public utility” as defined in N.J.S.A. 48:2.13.

During the performance of this contract, the contractor agrees as follows:
